
Referential

Reforest'Action is a social company specializing in reforestation worldwide. Our vocation is to provide private funds to field actors, specialists in reforestation and sustainable forest management. The objective of these funds is to finance the **restoration or creation of degraded forest ecosystems through community initiatives for planting, education and/or ecosystem preservation**. As such, the missions of the projects that Reforest'Action promotes and finances must respond to strong human, economic and environmental challenges.

Projects must meet various well-defined social, environmental and economic criteria. As such, it is important to note that:

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Our project selection criteria are based on the essential principles of a Common Multifunctionality Foundation specific to Reforest'Action. This foundation is a set of principles applicable to a tree planting or restoration project aimed at ensuring its ability to sustainably provide ecosystem services, resilience, adaptation and resilience to environmental disturbances (drought, insect attack, etc.).



Three other target principles may, as far as possible, be implemented, in particular in the light of advances in scientific knowledge:

- Mixed planting;

- Diversity of origin;
- Associative resistance

To this end, projects must aim to maintain, conserve or improve biodiversity at the level of landscapes, ecosystems, species and genetic levels.

This will be achieved through appropriate forest management practices, such as reforestation and afforestation with tree species and provenances adapted to site conditions or the use of maintenance, harvesting and transport techniques that minimize damage to trees and/or soil.

Similarly, the project leader must ensure that the health and vitality of forest ecosystems are maintained or improved and that degraded forest ecosystems are rehabilitated wherever and whenever economically possible, making the best use of natural structures and processes.

CONDITIONS OF APPLICABILITY

Reforest'Action is likely to carry out a project thanks to the impetus of funders: companies or individuals. The amount of funding is negotiated upstream with the project leader according to the agronomic, social and environmental potential of the project evaluated using indicators, its size and Reforest 'Action's financial resources.

The funds provided by Reforest'Action must be allocated to tree planting to the extent of the amounts that will be previously determined between the project leader and Reforest'Action.

Other funds may be provided by a public body, in which case Reforest'Action must be informed in the project document or in the monitoring document if the funds are obtained after the agreement with Reforest'Action has been signed. If the project leader is eligible for other private funds, the additionality of Reforest'Action aid must be verified.

PROJECT LEADER

Project leaders can be natural or legal entities (associations, NGOs, cooperatives, individuals, etc.) that can justify two years of activity on forestry projects.

Project leaders must provide the project description sheet, monitoring documents and supporting documents.

- The project leader must
- Have a bank account
- Be well structured and have a legal existence in the country in which it operates
- The owner(s) of the land must be known and the ownership of the land arising from written or customary law must be proven and communicated to Reforest'Action;

International projects referential

The project must not be subject to any exclusion and therefore must be able to include all people of good will:

- All forms of forced, compulsory or bonded labor are prohibited, including the use of trafficking and servitude, prison labor or work performed by soldiers, or the use of extortion, debt, threats, fines or financial penalties.
- All forms of discrimination related to work, hiring, training, assignments, social benefits, promotion policies and procedures, and other opportunities to obtain better conditions, pay or promotions, are prohibited.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

The main objective of the project must be to plant trees, restore or maintain forest ecosystems in a sustainable development approach that combines a social and ecological dimension with its objectives.

In other words, this means that Reforest'Action project leaders contribute in a measurable way to a more equitable society, promoting the development of living beings and contributing to better access to water, education, health and human food while respecting the well-being of local communities and ecosystems. Planting, protection or restoration projects must involve at least three indigenous or endemic species of different trees.

PROJECT LOCATION

Projects can take place in all countries, except those placed in the red zone by the French Ministry of Europe and Foreign Affairs: <https://www.diplomatie.gouv.fr/fr/conseils-aux-voyageurs/>.

SIZE OF THE PROJECT

The project must ensure the planting of a minimum of 10,000 trees per year. Planting can take place in one piece or on different plots with a similar context.

PROJECT PERIOD

The project may have been implemented before the agreement signed with Reforest'Action but payments will be made for actions carried out from the date of signature.

MONITORING

The project leader must set up the necessary means to be able to provide the GPS location of the plantations (DMS format - degrees / minutes / seconds / N or S) as well as the species and number of trees planted.

International projects referential

This information will be provided to Reforest'Action as part of the follow-up and may be verified during an audit.

The project leader must provide once every 3 months the monitoring document completed with information on the progress of the operations, the difficulties encountered and good quality photos. Photos that will be the exclusive property of Reforest'Action. The information provided as part of the follow-up will enable Reforest'Action to draw up an annual report. This report will include several documents and should make it possible to measure the benefits related to the project and provide retrospective information month by month on the past planting year. It will include an Excel document summarizing the project (which will be sent to you blank), as well as a file detailing month by month all the actions carried out by the project leader and including figures on the effective measurement of living conditions.

Reforest'Action reserves the right to carry out audits at the project site during the first five years from the date of signature of the agreement.
